- Four exterior colors: Precision Red, Blue Metallic, Bordeaux Red and Red Jewel Tintcoat (extra cost)

## ACTIVE FUEL MANAGEMENT

The 3.9L V6 and 5.3L small block V8 engines in the 2007 Impala feature Active Fuel Management technology to provide added fuel efficiency (20 mpg city/29 mpg highway) by temporarily shutting down half the engine's cylinders during lighter-load conditions such as highway driving. The process is seamless and virtually imperceptible.

## FLIP AND FOLD-FLAT SEATS

Impala's unique flip and fold-flat rear seat is an exclusive feature in the midsize segment. The forward-flip rear seat cushions create a covered storage area beneath the seat with cushions down and offers convenient grocery bag hooks when the cushions are flipped forward. The seat back also folds down to create a generous pass-through from the trunk when the seat backs are folded flat.

### DETAILED NOTES:

1. Always use safety belts and the correct child restraint for your child's age and size, even in vehicles equipped with air bags. Head curtain air bags are designed to help reduce the risk of head and neck injuries to front and out-board rear-seat occupants during certain side-impact collisions.

4. Cargo and load capacity limited by weight and distribution.

5. Gross Vehicle Weight Rating (GVWR). When properly equipped, includes vehicle, passengers, cargo and equipment.
6. Maximum payload capacity includes weight of driver, passengers, optional equipment and cargo. Cargo and load capacity limited by weight and distribution.
7. Maximum Trailer Weight ratings are calculated assuming a base vehicle, except for options necessary to achieve the rating, plus driver. The weight of other optional equipment, passengers and cargo will reduce the maximum trailer weight your vehicle can tow.
