- Z71 Off Road appearance package, including larger recovery hook openings; larger, more prominent fog lamps; specific grille texture; platinum chrome grille trim; 18-inch wheels; and on-road/off-road tires.
- Autoride suspension system standard on LTZ. It's a segment-exclusive, bi-state, real-time damping system that provides an extremely refined ride with greatly reduced body motion.
- E85 capability is standard on 4WD models. E85 is a renewable fuel made of 85 percent ethanol and 15 percent gasoline. GM vehicles with E85 capability can run on 100 percent gasoline or on E85 or any combination of the two fuels.
- Interior features include power-release fold-and-tumble second-row seat, remote vehicle starting system, first- and second-row heated seats, Ultrasonic Rear Parking assist and rearview camera system, touch-screen navigation system DVD rear-seat entertainment system.
